

SEASONS & WEATHER OF CORBETT TIGER RESERVE

Winter (November to February) –

- During the winter, temperatures vary from 0-5°C at night to 15-25°C in the day
- This period is referred to as the 'season' to visit Corbett as all its designated Tourism Zones are open for Safaris and Night Stays
- Warm clothes, an all-weather jumper, and thermals, if you feel particularly cold, would make your safari a better experience.

Summer (April to June) –

- During the summer, the heat can touch 45°C in certain areas of Corbett, and average temperatures range from 20-25°C at night to 35-45°C in the day
- This is an excellent period for game viewing, as most animals converge around sources of water and the sparse vegetation adds to sighting opportunities
- Broad brimmed hats, sunscreen, and full-sleeved light cotton clothing are recommended.

Monsoon (July to September) –

- During the monsoon, Corbett receives moderate to heavy rainfall with average temperature varying between 25-35°C through the day
- The period is particularly enchanting with Corbett at its greenest, with lush vegetation, butterflies and recently-hatched juvenile birds; intermittent rain adding to the jungle's romance
- An extra pair of shoes and an all-weather wind-cheater would be the order of this season.
